The text looks like it?s been painted on too, with letters of varying size and thickness, but it?s all clear and imaginative. A lovely title, sure to be a favourite with little ones. (See also **Hello Dudley!**, **Calm Down, Boris!** and **Wendy the wide-mouthed Frog** in the same series.)
