Gorgeous illustrations and a very simple text make this an ideal story for little ones who are learning their first words. Children will recognise situations and remember Archie?s story might be a useful technique when parents are faced with their own examples. The lovely double spread pages are a particular delight and ?No!? is sure to produce giggles all round. Any offer of a repeat read is sure to be greeted with a resounding Yes!
