It's the Second World War and an American soldier is billeted with a New Zealand family. Jackson Coop is black and his impact on the small community is far-reaching and lasting. Rex, son of the host family, learns what real heroism is; Leo - a Dalmatian - refuses to be a victim of prejudice; Dawn protects her vulnerable grandmother and demonstrates the power of loyalty.

Unlike **To Kill a Mockingbird**, *The Champion* gives its black protagonist three dimensions and its readers a view of war and prejudice from his side of the fence. An excellent read for 3rd year pupils.
