A re-issue of one of the 'Share-a-Story' series first published in 1987. The idea behind 'Share-a-Story' is to support newish readers by offering the story as a dialogue between the left- and right-hand pages so that an adult and a young reader can take turns at reading alternate pages as different characters. Don't be misled into believing the words 'Beginner Readers' on the cover, however, since the child needs to be a fairly experienced reader to predict, connect and decode the text. They do offer an excellent way to encourage family togetherness and to encourage reasonably able, but reluctant readers to take part ...and the series works perfectly well as conventional stories to read aloud. This story about Granny's naughty childhood ('we had to behave in my day') is entertaining and the text is enriched by Faith Jaques' lively artwork. Other titles in the re-issued set are **Thank You for the Tadpole, My Friend Mr Morris, No Trouble at All, The Best Thing of All**, all by Pat Thomson with various illustrators. The reading difficulty and attraction of the story varies from book to book so, as with all series, choose carefully.
